## Irish Rovers

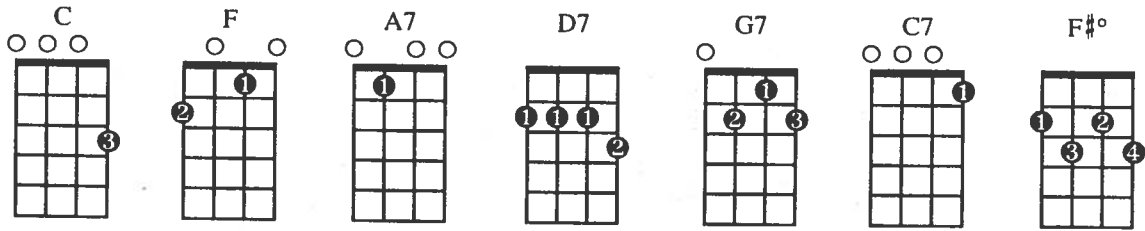
