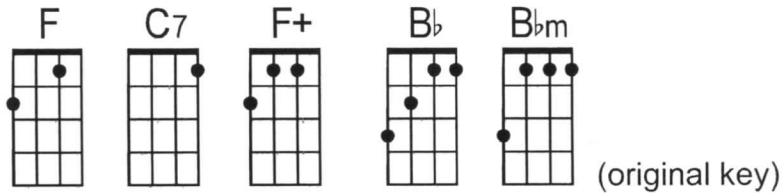


Blue Bayou (original key of F)
