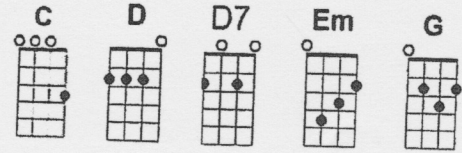


# Take Me Home, Country Roads
