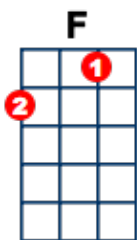
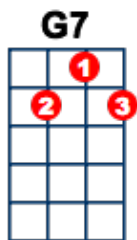
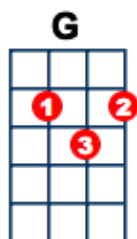
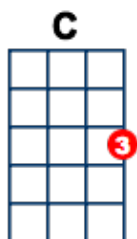


The Happy Wanderer
